Ride & Attraction Descriptions

Wipeout

Height Restrictions: Must be 42” to ride and children cannot sit alone

This spinning ride rotates around the ride axis while moving in an up and down motion simultaneously. Guests must have upper body control and the ability to sit up straight. A lap bar and seatbelt must be locked and secure at all times. Guests must securely lock or remove any prostheses before boarding the ride to ensure the safety of other Guests. Due to the nature of this ride, Guests may need companion assistance transferring to a ride vehicle. All Guests using wheelchairs or those with other disabilities should use the ADA entrance located next to the exit of the ride. Notify the Ride Operator by ringing the ADA bell and wait until the Operator tells you it is safe to enter.

X-Scream

Height Restrictions: Must be 48” to ride

This 140’ drop tower ride slowly pulls riders up in the air before dropping them in a freefall. The ride has an over the shoulder restraint that is locked by the Ride Operator. Guests must have upper body control and be able to sit up straight with their head against the seat back. Guests must securely lock or remove any prostheses before boarding the ride to ensure the safety of other Guests. Due to the nature of this ride, Guests may need companion assistance transferring to a ride vehicle. All Guests using wheelchairs or those with other disabilities should use the ADA entrance located next to the exit of the ride. Notify the Ride Operator by ringing the ADA bell and wait until the Operator tells you it is safe to enter.

Accessibility

Waldameer is committed to providing a safe environment for all our Guests and strictly enforces all safety regulations in accordance with the Pennsylvania Rides Safety and Liability Act and Pennsylvania State Amusement Ride Inspection Act and in doing so reserves the right to refuse any Guest admission to any ride.

PA Act No. 1994-58 Amusement Rider Safety and Liability

Act: The PA Amusement Rider Safety and Liability Act requires that all riders obey all warnings and directions regarding the ride and must behave in a manner that will not cause or contribute to injury to themselves or others. Failure to comply is cause for dismissal from the park without refund.

Safety is designed into all areas of Waldameer. While most of our rides are accessible to those with disabilities, it should be noted that, in the interest of personal safety, some Guests might not be permitted to board certain rides. Access criteria is based on any Guest's ability to:

- Have the mental capacity to be aware of hazards to themselves or others
- Utilize all safety devices and restraints
- Meet the height requirements
- Maintain proper riding posture throughout the course of the ride
- Safely evacuate the ride if needed

Most attractions, games, gift shops and food stands are accessible to all our Guests. In some cases, however, Guests may need the assistance from a member in their party. No Guest may compromise the safety or welfare of other Guests or Employees.

Riding the Rides

Guests with recent surgery, heart problems, high blood pressure, neck or back problems, seizures, pregnancy, or have any other condition that may be aggravated by riding must use discretion in selecting which rides to ride.

Umbrella Ride

Height Restrictions: Must be 30" – 54"

Guests riding this rotating children's round ride must have upper body control and the ability to sit up straight. A seat belt must be worn at all times. Due to the nature of this ride, Guests may need companion assistance transferring to a ride vehicle.

Wet Boats

Height Restrictions: Must be 30" – 54"

Guests riding this rotating children's round ride must have upper body control and the ability to sit up straight. Due to the nature of this ride, Guests may need companion assistance transferring to a ride vehicle.

Whacky Shack

Height Restrictions: Must be 42" to ride alone, 30" – 42" must be accompanied

This Bill Tracy dark ride takes riders through a funhouse filled with strobe lights and lighting effects, loud sirens and horns as well as sharp turns. Guests must have upper body control and the ability to sit up straight with a lap bar placed in front of them for the entire ride. Due to the nature of this ride, Guests may need companion assistance transferring to a ride vehicle. All Guests using wheelchairs or those with other disabilities should enter the ride at the exit. Notify the Ride Operator and they will let you in when it is safe to do so.

Wendy's Tea Party

Height Restrictions: Must be 36" to ride alone, 30" – 36" must be accompanied
Guests riding this spinning family ride revolve atop a simultaneously rotating ride base. Guests must meet all safety requirements, which include upper body control and the ability to sit up straight. Due to the nature of this ride, Guests may need companion assistance in transferring to a ride vehicle. All Guests using wheelchairs or those with other disabilities should use the ADA entrance located across from to the exit of the ride. Notify the Ride Operator by ringing the ADA bell and wait until the Operator tells you it is safe to enter.

Thunder River

Height Restrictions: Must be 42" to ride alone, 36" – 42" must be accompanied
This log flume ride floats Guests through moving water and drops them down two hills, the highest being 40'. Due to the operating systems, Guests must be able to Load and unload in a timely manner. Guests must have upper body control and be able to sit up straight. Be aware that strobe lights are used at this ride for ride photography and in the Thunder River tunnel and YOU WILL GET WET. Due to the nature of this ride, Guests may need companion assistance in transferring to a ride vehicle. All Guests using wheelchairs or those with other disabilities should use the ADA entrance located next to the exit of the ride. Notify the Ride Operator by ringing the ADA bell and wait until the Operator tells you it is safe to enter.

Tilt-A-Whirl

Height Restrictions: Must be 46" to ride alone, 36" – 46" must be accompanied
This ride features a spinning platform as well as free spinning ride vehicles. Guests must have upper body control and be able to sit up straight. The restraint is a lap bar that goes across multiple riders. Due to the nature of this ride, Guests may need companion assistance in transferring to a ride vehicle. This ride has steps at both the

Accessibility

You know your medical history, limitations and restrictions, Waldameer does not. Therefore, YOU must use good judgment deciding which rides to ride.

Our primary concern is your ability to endure the dynamics of a ride without risk to yourself, other riders or staff members. If you suspect your health could be at risk, or you could aggravate a pre-existing condition, DO NOT RIDE.

We encourage you to watch each ride through it's loading, running and unloading cycle to understand its operation. This allows you to gather information about the ride and make an informed decision about which rides to go on.

All Guests should be aware that, although remote, there is always the possibility that mechanical problems, power failure or adverse weather conditions could occur leading to a sudden stoppage of a ride.

In that event, riders may be required to evacuate the ride over catwalks or travel down steeply inclined ramps or steps.

Ride operators are not permitted or trained to physically assist Guests onto or off rides.

Most of Waldameer & Water World is accessible to our Guests with disabilities. All disability entrances and exits are clearly marked at all rides and attractions.

Ticket Information

For the purpose of this guide, a responsible person is one who meets all requirements to ride the ride, be at least sixteen (16) years of age and appears mature enough to safely accompany the disabled Guest. In the case of immediate family, the age for responsible person may be waived at the discretion of Waldameer.

Ride Exit Pass

For our Guests with disabilities that cannot use the entrance, Waldameer offers a special wristband which allows him/her to board the rides through the exit gates. The exit pass wristband allows the disabled Guest and three (3) additional Guests, **for a total of four** (4), to board the rides through the exit gate. The disabled Guest **MUST RIDE** in order for the Guests accompanying him/her to enter the ride through the exit.

One or more accompanying Guest must be able to physically assist the disabled Guest on and off the ride if help is required.

Tickets

Waldameer offers free admission to the amusement park. All day ride passes can be purchased at the Merry-Go-Round Ticket Booths located on the midway. The middle booth has a disability accessible window for purchasing. Regular prices apply. (Waldameer does not issue rain checks or refunds.) Wally Point Cards, which are honored at all rides, food, games and gift shops can be purchased at self serve kiosks or the Ticket Booths.

If you are wheelchair bound and physically cannot use Water World's attractions, you do not have to pay the

Sky Ride

Height Restrictions: Must be 46" to ride alone, 36" – 46" must be accompanied

This chair lift ride takes riders up 35' in the air over the midway. The ride has a lap bar that must be secure at all times. Guests must be able to sit up straight. Guests must securely lock or remove any prostheses before boarding the ride to ensure the safety of other Guests. This is a continuous moving ride and normally does not stop to load or unload riders. If needed, the ride may be stopped to load and unload by informing the Ride Operator in advance. Due to the nature of this ride, Guests may need companion assistance in transferring to a ride vehicle. All Guests using wheelchairs or those with other disabilities should use the ride exit and wait until the Operator tells you it is safe to board.

Spider

Height Restrictions: Must be 46" to ride alone, 36" – 46" must be accompanied

This spinning ride rotates around the ride axis while moving in an up and down motion simultaneously. Guests will be stopped several times while the ride seats are loaded and unloaded. Guests must have upper body control and the ability to sit up straight. A lap bar must be engaged at all times. Due to the nature of this ride, Guests may need companion assistance in transferring to a ride vehicle. All Guests using wheelchairs or those with other disabilities should use the ride exit and wait until the Operator tells you it is safe to board.

Steel Dragon

Height Restrictions: Must be 50" to ride alone, 46" – 50" must be accompanied, 78" maximum

This steel coaster includes a 49' drop and quick turns while the ride vehicle spins. Guests must have upper body strength and be able to sit upright with the restraint fastened. The restraint mechanism is a lap bar that must lock completely and remain secured for the entire ride. Guests must securely lock or remove any prostheses before boarding the ride to ensure the safety of other Guests. Due to the nature of this ride, Guests may need companion assistance in transferring to a ride vehicle. All Guests using wheelchairs or those with other disabilities should use the ADA entrance located next to the exit of the ride. Notify

Scrambler

Height Restrictions: Must be 48” to ride alone, 36” – 48” must be accompanied

This multi-direction rotating family ride spins on the ride axis and simultaneously on the axis of the ride vehicles. Guests must have upper body control and the ability to sit up straight with the restraint fastened. A lap bar must be engaged at all times. Larger Guests should sit in the outermost seat. Guests must securely lock or remove any prostheses before boarding the ride to ensure the safety of other Guests. Due to the nature of the ride, Guests may need companion assistance transferring from their wheelchair to the ride vehicle. Guests with wheelchairs or other disabilities should enter using the ride exit. Notify the Ride Operator and they will tell you when it is safe to enter the ride.

Sea Dragon

Height Restrictions: Must be 48” to ride alone, 36” – 48” must be accompanied

This swinging ship ride swings 54’ in the air. Guests must have upper body control and the ability to sit up straight with the restraint fastened. A lap bar must be engaged at all times. Due to the nature of the ride, Guests may need companion assistance transferring from their wheelchair to the ride vehicle. Guests in wheelchairs or other disabilities should use the ADA entrance located next to the exit to the ride. Notify the Ride Operator by ringing the ADA Bell. The Operator will release the ADA entrance when it is safe to enter the ride.

Sky Fighter

Height Restrictions: Must be 30” – 54”

Guests riding this rotating children’s round ride must have upper body control and the ability to sit up straight. A seat belt must be worn at all times. Due to the nature of this ride, Guests may need companion assistance transferring to a ride vehicle.

General Admission to enter the water park.

First Aid

Waldameer & Water World each have their own First Aid Office. Waldameer’s First Aid is located in the Park Office next to the Paratrooper. Water World’s First Aid is in the rear of the Bath House where the All-Day Lockers are located. If you should have a medical emergency, please contact the nearest Team Member who will notify First Aid to respond.

Service Animals

Domestic service animals are welcome in most locations throughout Waldameer. Animals must be in the owner’s control and under control at all times. Service animals must be on a harness or leash no longer than six feet. Owners are responsible for cleaning and disposing of any animal waste.

Service animals are not allowed on any rides or attractions at Waldameer. If you wish to ride or enjoy one of the attractions, we suggest a companion visit the Park with you to care for your service animal. Service animals must not be left unattended or with Waldameer Team Members. Waldameer reserves the right to limit any service animal when safety is in question.

Guest Services

Waldameer’s Guest Services is located at the Park Office next to the Paratrooper. Guest Services is able to provide brochures, park maps, ride exit passes and any information about Park amenities and services. Guest Services can also get in contact with any of the area Supervisors if questions need answered.

General Information

Wheelchair Rentals

Wheelchairs are available for daily rental on a first-come, first-serve basis. Wheelchairs are \$7.00 per day. A license or major credit card is required as collateral until you return the wheelchair. Wheelchairs can be rented and returned at the Merry-Go-Round Ticket Booths along with strollers and wagons.

Smoking

Smoking at Waldameer & Water World is permitted only in designated smoking areas. These areas are located throughout the park and indicated on the Park Map by this symbol:



Gift Shops

Waldameer gift shops are accessible to Guests with disabilities. Please ask any Waldameer Team Member if you need assistance reaching items.

Medical Restrictions

All Ride and Attraction Safety Information is posted at each ride/attraction entrance so that you may make informed decisions on your ability to safely participate. This brochure describes the ride's movements and forces while the ride safety signs include medical restrictions and special safety instructions that may affect your participation on the attraction.

Ride & Attraction Descriptions

Ravine Flyer II

Height Restrictions: Must be 48" to ride

This wooden coaster ride includes a 120' drop, extreme banking and speeds up to 60 miles per hour. All riders must have upper body control and the ability to sit up straight with the restraint fastened during quick left and right turns. The restraint mechanism is a lap bar and seat belt that must lock completely and remain secure for the entire ride. Guests must securely lock or remove any prostheses before boarding the ride to ensure the safety of other Guests. Due to the nature of this ride, Guests may need companion assistance transferring from their wheelchair to a ride vehicle. Guests using wheelchairs or other disabilities should use the ADA entrance located at the exit to the ride. Ring the ADA Bell to notify the Ride Operators and they will release the ADA entrance when it is safe to enter the ride.

Ravine Flyer 3

Height Restrictions: Must be 40" to ride

This miniature roller coaster takes Guests up and down slopes and through various curves. Guests must have upper body control and be able to sit up straight. The ride has a lap bar that secures across the riders. Larger Guests should sit in the outermost seat. Due to the nature of this ride, Guests may need companion assistance transferring from their wheelchair to the ride vehicle.

SS Wally

Height Restrictions: Must be 42" to ride alone, 30" – 42" must be accompanied

This ride rocks Guests back and forth on a half pipe track while the tug boat spins. Guests must be able to sit upright with their lap bar in place. Due to the nature of this ride, Guests may need companion assistance transferring from their wheelchair to the ride vehicle. Guests with wheelchairs should use the ADA entrance located at the exit to the ride. Notify the Ride Operator by ringing the ADA Bell and the Operator will let you in when it is safe to enter.

Ride & Attraction Descriptions

Mini Enterprise

Height Restrictions: Must be 30” – 54”

This children’s helicopter ride rises 10’ in the air and rotates. Guests must have upper body control and be able to sit upright. A seatbelt must be worn at all times. Due to the nature of this ride, Guests may need companion assistance transferring from their wheelchair to the ride vehicle.

Paratrooper

Height Restrictions: Must be 46” to ride alone, 36” – 46” must be accompanied

Guests will spin counterclockwise and be raised 30’ in the air while riding this ride. Guest must have upper body control and the ability to sit straight up with the restraint fastened. A lap bar must be engaged at all times. Larger Guests should sit in the outermost seat. Guests must securely lock or remove any prostheses before boarding the ride to ensure the safety of other Guests. Due to the nature of the ride, Guests may need companion assistance transferring from their wheelchair to the ride vehicle. This ride has three (3) steps to reach the loading platform. Guests with wheelchairs or other disabilities may use the ADA entrance located next to the Potato Patch. Let the Ride Operator know you are waiting to ride and they will let you into the ride when it is safe to do so.

Pirate’s Cove

Height Restrictions: Must be 42” to ride alone, 30” – 42” must be accompanied

This Bill Tracy walkthrough ride takes Guests through narrow hallways, wooden bridges and tilted rooms. Guests must be able to walk unassisted in order to ride. Due to the nature of this ride, wheelchairs or walking devices will not fit into the ride.

Pony Carts

Height Restrictions: Must be 30” to 54”

This children’s ride travels in a circle while the horse pulled chariots bounce up and down. Guests must be able to sit up straight with the restraint fastened. A seatbelt must be worn at all times. Due to the nature of this ride, Guests may need companion assistance transferring from their wheelchair to the ride vehicle.

Ride Guidelines & Rules

Remember: Waldameer does not know your medical history or restrictions. Please review all safety information prior to boarding or utilizing the attraction. Please be aware of all medical and height restrictions. We also encourage you to watch the ride or attraction prior to choosing to ride. If in doubt, do not ride.

Food & Drink

You may finish food and drinks while waiting in line. However, eating, drinking or chewing gum or candy while riding is prohibited.

Securing Loose Items

Glass items, game prizes, umbrellas, canes, crutches, caps, glasses, cameras and other loose items must be left with a non-riding member of your party or stored in a Park rental locker or your personal vehicle. Some rides provide shelves or bins to store these items while riding; however, Waldameer is not responsible for items damaged, lost or stolen during your ride/attraction experience.

Remember: Ride Operators are assigned and in place to ensure Guest safety and to operate the ride. Thus, they cannot be responsible for Guest’s personal items. Park rental lockers are available for rent, and locations are indicated on the Park Map by this symbol:



Ride Guidelines & Rules

Artificial Limbs & Amputees

On some rides, Guests who are amputees or those with artificial limbs may be unable to participate due to the inability to be properly restrained during the ride or attraction. Guests may be asked to securely lock or remove any prostheses before boarding to ensure the safety of other Guests.

Boarding a Ride or Experiencing an Attraction

Guests using wheelchairs or those with other disabilities may use the marked disability entrances to gain access to the ride or attraction. A maximum of three (3) Guests may accompany a Guest using the ride or attraction's marked disability entrance. The party shall not exceed a total of four (4) Guests. These entrances are designed to provide access to the ride, not to expedite your wait. You may have to wait once reaching the loading area. If you need assistance transferring from your wheelchair, you must visit the Park with a companion. Our Ride Operators may provide information or answer questions; however, they are not trained to assist you in transferring to and from a ride vehicle and will not be able to do so.

Many of our rides and attractions subject the human body to forces and movements which create thrills and excitement we tend to enjoy. Each ride is different and unique in relationship to these forces and movements. A rider's age, height, weight, medical history/condition and body stature will affect the way the body reacts. This limits the use of some of our rides. Our Guests that comply with ride safety requirements are welcome to ride as

enter the ride through the Exit. Notify the Ride Operator that you are waiting to ride and the Operator will allow you to enter when it is safe

L. Ruth Express

Height Restrictions: Must be 42" to ride alone, 30"- 42" must be accompanied

This miniature C.P. Huntington train travels a one-mile loop. The train car directly behind the locomotive has wheelchair accessibility to permit one wheelchair onto the ride. Guests with wheelchairs or other disabilities should enter through the Exit of the ride. Wait at the Exit until the Ride Operator tells you it is safe to enter the ride.

Mega Vortex

Height Restrictions: Must be 48" to ride

This spinning swing ride travels back and forth along a 122' half pipe track while spinning in both directions. The ride's maximum height is 47' and features motorcycle style seats with adjusted back restraints. Guests must have upper body control and be able to sit upright with their feet flat on the floor and the seat restraint fastened at all times. Guests must securely lock or remove any prostheses before boarding the ride to ensure the safety of other Guests. Due to the nature of this ride, Guests may need companion assistance transferring from their wheelchair to the ride vehicle. Guests with wheelchairs or other disabilities may enter using the ADA entrance next to the Exit of the ride. Notify the Ride Operator that you are waiting to ride by ringing the ADA Bell. The Operator will release the ADA entrance and allow you to enter when it is safe.

Merry-Go-Round

Height Restrictions: Must be 42" to ride alone, 30" – 42" must be accompanied

On this nostalgic family carousel ride, the horses move up and down as the ride revolves. Guests must be able to step up onto and straddle the moving horse in order to ride. Guests must have upper body control and be able to sit upright. Guests who do not want to ride on a moving horse may sit in one of the two stationary chariots. Due to the nature of this ride, Guests may need companion assistance transferring from their wheelchair to the ride vehicle.

Ride & Attraction Descriptions

Frog Hopper

Height Restrictions: Must be 30” - 54” to ride, adults may ride with children

This children’s ride takes Guests 20’ in the air and bounces them down to the ground. Guests must sit with their legs dangling. The ride has a lap bar that is locked by the Ride Operator. Guests larger in size may be unable to ride due to the ride’s locking mechanism. The outermost seats are designed to accommodate adults. Guests must have upper body control and be able to sit upright with their head against the seat back. Guests must securely lock or remove any prostheses before boarding the ride. Due to the nature of this ride, Guests may need companion assistance transferring from their wheelchair to the ride vehicle. Guests with wheelchairs may enter the ride through the exit. Wait for an Operator to tell you when it is safe to enter.

Flying Swings

Height Restrictions: Must be 48” to ride alone, 36” – 48” must be accompanied

This large, revolving, tilting family swing ride rotates, ascends over 20’ up in the air and tilts. Guests must have upper body control and the ability to sit up straight with the restraint fastened. A lap bar must be engaged at all times. Guests must securely lock or remove any prostheses before boarding to ensure the safety of other Guests. Due to the nature of this ride, Guests may need companion assistance transferring from their wheelchair to the ride vehicle. Guests with wheelchairs or other disabilities may enter the ride at the Exit. Ring the ADA Bell to let the Ride Operator you are waiting to ride. The Operator will open the ADA entrance when it is safe to enter the ride.

Lil’ Toot

Height Restrictions: Must be 30” – 54”

This children’s handcar ride allows children to crank their own car around a looping track. Guests must have upper body control and arm strength in order to move their ride vehicle. A seatbelt must be fastened at all times. If a child is unable to move the ride vehicle alone, an adult may use a pushing rod in order to help the child. Due to the nature of this ride, Guests may need companion assistance transferring from their wheelchair to the ride vehicle. Guests with wheelchairs or other disabilities may

many time as they wish during their visit, but they must exit the ride vehicle and rejoin the line each time they do so.

Ride/Attraction Evacuations

Evacuations may be required in the unlikely event of mechanical difficulties or inclement weather. In the event of an evacuation, Guests may need to maneuver across catwalks and/or descend steep steps, sometimes from the highest point of the ride. Those unable to evacuate may need to wait, restrained in their seats for extended periods of time, until assistance arrives. Please consider this before deciding to ride.

Other Mobility Devices

Golf carts, Segway personal transporters, bicycles, tricycles, roller skates, skateboards and scooters are not allowed for use in our Park. Wheelchair, stroller and wagon rental is located at the Merry-Go-Round Ticket Booths on the midway.

Restraint Systems

All Guests must fit properly into all ride restraint systems. If a Guest does not fit properly in the restraint system, they will not be able to ride that ride.

For the safety of Guests nearby, those wearing casts, braces or prostheses may be unable to ride due to the inability to be properly restrained.

Oxygen Tanks

Due to the forces, speeds and movements of our rides, oxygen tanks are not permitted on ride vehicles. Oxygen tanks are allowed on the L. Ruth Express only.

Ali Baba

Height Restrictions: Must be 42” to ride

This 55’ rotating carpet ride swings Guests in a full circle in both directions, multiple times. Guests must have upper body control and the ability to sit up straight with their head against the seat back. The ride has an over-the-shoulder harness locked by a Ride Operator. Guests must securely lock or remove any prostheses before boarding to ensure the safety of other Guests. Due to the nature of this ride, Guests may need companion assistance when transferring from their wheelchair to the ride vehicle. Guests with wheelchairs or those with disabilities may enter the ride at the Exit. Let the Ride Operator know you are waiting at the Exit by ringing the ADA Bell. The Operator will release the ADA entrance door when it is safe to enter.

Big Rigs

Height Restrictions: Must be 36” - 54” to ride alone, 30” – 36” must be accompanied

Guests ride inside or on top of mini semi trucks as they slowly follow a track on this children’s ride. Guests must have upper body control and be able to sit upright with their restraint fastened. A seatbelt must be worn at all times. The rear seats are larger to accommodate adults who wish to sit with their child. Due to the nature of this ride, Guests may need companion assistance transferring from their wheel chair to the ride vehicle. Guests with wheelchairs or those with disabilities should wait at the Exit to ride. The Ride Operator will let you know when it is safe to enter the ride.

Comet

Height Restrictions: Must be 46” to ride alone, 36” – 46” must be accompanied

This wooden coaster features plenty of airtime, a 25’ drop and travels up to 25 miles per hour. Guests must have upper body control as well as be able to sit up straight with the restraint fastened. The restraint mechanism is a lap bar that must lock completely and remain secure for the entire ride. Guests must lock or remove any prostheses before boarding this ride.

Ride & Attraction Descriptions

Due to the nature of this ride, Guests may need companion assistance transferring from their wheelchair to the ride vehicle. Guests with wheelchairs or other disabilities may use the ADA entrance located next to the exit. To notify the Ride Operator, ring the ADA Bell located next to the ADA entrance. The Operator will release the entrance and allow you to enter when it is safe.

Dodg’ems

Height Restrictions: Must be 48” to drive, 42” – 48” to be a passenger

Guests on this family bumper car ride will experience collisions caused by you or other drivers. Passengers 42-48” are required to use the shoulder straps provided. Guests who drive must be able to reach the floor pedal and steer the car simultaneously. Drivers and passengers must have upper body control and the ability to sit up straight during the ride’s sudden accelerations and stops. The lap bar must be engaged at all times. Due to the nature of this ride, Guests may need companion assistance when transferring from their wheel chair to the ride vehicle. Guests who use wheelchairs or those with other disabilities should enter the ride through the Exit. Let the Ride Operator know you are waiting at the Exit by ringing the ADA Bell. The Ride Operator will let you know when it is safe to enter.

Ferris Wheel

Height Restrictions: Must be 42” to ride, 30” – 42” must be accompanied

On this 100’ tall family Ferris Wheel ride, Guests will be stopped several times while the ride seats are loaded and unloaded. Guests must have the ability to sit up straight. The manufacturer of this ride does not allow any single riders. A Guest must be accompanied by at least one other Guest in order to ride. Due to the nature of this ride, Guests may need companion assistance transferring from their wheelchair to the ride vehicle. Guests with wheelchairs or other disabilities should ring the ADA Bell located at the Exit to the ride in order to alert the Ride Operator. The Operator will release the ADA entrance when it is safe to enter the ride.
